Things four Way

The walk begins at Fermyn Woods Country Park which is open all day, everyday. Admission is free although there is a small charge for the use of the carpar. The walk can also be accessed from Lyveden New Beld (National Tinat) or Waderche village. The Lyveden Way leafest shows the moute in man form. The is supported on the ground by frogerposts, waymark posts, bridges and gates. These bear distinctive waymark ymarkers and directional arrows as shown in this picture.

Ordnance Survey Map

When walking the Lyveden Way it may be useful to carry a Ordnance Survey Map. These could either be the Landranger Series at a scale of 1:50,000 or the Explorer Series at a scale of 1:25,000. These maps are available from Tourist Information Centres, Fermyn Woods Country Park and most bookshops. For this walk you will need Landranger Series 141 or Explorer 224.

Safe Walking

Be prepared - always wear suitable clothing and sturdy footwear, take refreshments and directions. Take care when crossing or walking on roadways (walk facing oncoming traffic).
